BURBANK OPTIONS



OPTION 1

ASK YOUR RETAILER ABOUT TAKING IT BACK

When a retailer delivers your new mattress, they are required to offer to take your old one back.

Ask that your retailer pre-arranges old mattress pickup with the new mattress delivery.



OPTION 3

SCHEDULE A CURBSIDE PICKUP

If you aren't able to use the retailer take back option, the City of Burbank offers mattress pickup services for a fee.

OPTION 2

BRING IT TO THE COLLECTION SITE AT BURBANK RECYCLE CENTER

Residents can drop off up to three mattresses per year for free.

OPTION 4

OR TAKE IT TO A PARTICIPATING RECYCLING FACILITY AND GET \$3 BACK

Mattresses are processed in the LA area at Cristal Materials, Mat Services and R5 Recycling. Get \$3 back if you take your mattresses to one of their locations. Visit ByeByeMattress.com for location and payment details.

Of course, some exceptions apply to all of these above locations, so flip over to the backside for further details.

California's Used Mattress Recovery and Recycling Act requires the mattress industry to create and administer a recycling program for mattresses and box springs used and discarded in the state. The Mattress Recycling Council (MRC) is a nonprofit organization certified by CalRecycle to plan and manage the program known as Bye Bye Mattress. MRC uses the recycling fee collected on new mattress sales to establish collection locations, fund community collection events, combat illegal dumping and more.





Which items are accepted and not accepted by the program?

WHAT WE ACCEPT:

Traditional spring and foam mattresses, box springs, and futon mattresses that separate from the frame or base

WE ARE UNABLE TO ACCEPT:

- Severely damaged, wet, twisted, frozen or soiled mattresses or box springs
- Items infested with bed bugs
- Mattress pads or toppers
- Sleeping bags
- Pillows
- Car beds
- Juvenile products such as carriages, baskets, cribs, bassinets, dressing tables, strollers, and playpens or their pads
- Infant carriers, lounge pads, or crib bumpers
- Water beds or camping air mattresses
- Fold-out sofa beds and futon frames or bases
- Furniture

THINGS TO NOTE ABOUT THE RETAILER TAKE BACK:

- A retailer may refuse to pick up the old mattress if it poses a health or safety risk.
- Mattress delivery or set-up fees can still be applied.

RULES AT THE BURBANK RECYCLE CENTER AND CURBSIDE PICKUP:

- Burbank residents may drop off three units per year for free. Fees apply for four or more. Call 818-276-0434 for pricing. (*Burbank Recycle Center is only a collection site and does not pay the \$3 per unit.*)
- Residents can arrange for a City of Burbank curbside pickup for a fee if the mattress does not qualify for a free retailer pickup under the State of California law. Schedule using the Our Burbank 311 app or <https://burbankca.gov/bulkyitem>.
- Infested mattresses must be put in a special bed bug disposal bag and clearly marked (disposal bags available at local retailers).

RULES AT MATTRESS RECYCLING FACILITIES:

- Residents and businesses can drop off any number of units for free during each mattress recycling facilities' business hours.
- Residents will receive \$3 per unit, up to 5 units per vehicle per day. Business or large volume drop-offs do not qualify for the reimbursement.
