

## NOTICE TO VOTERS OF DATE AFTER WHICH NO PROTESTS MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY CLERK

BURBANK, Calif. (December 4, 2024) – NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN the General Municipal Election was held in the City of Burbank on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. According to the Burbank Municipal Code (§2-3-145), within five (5) days after the results of the election have been posted, any voter of the City may file a verified written protest with the City Clerk contesting the count of the ballots. Such protest shall set forth specifically the following:

1. The name and address of the voter protesting;

2. The name of the person whose right to be nominated or elected to office, stating the office, is being contested; or the proposition being contested;

3. The number of the precinct or precincts wherein it is claimed errors in the counting of ballots would give a different result, if corrected;

- 4. A statement of particulars as to the errors claimed to have been made in the original count;
- 5. A demand for a recount of the ballots cast in the specified precinct or precincts; and,

6. A deposit in an amount estimated by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to cover the cost of the recount.
