

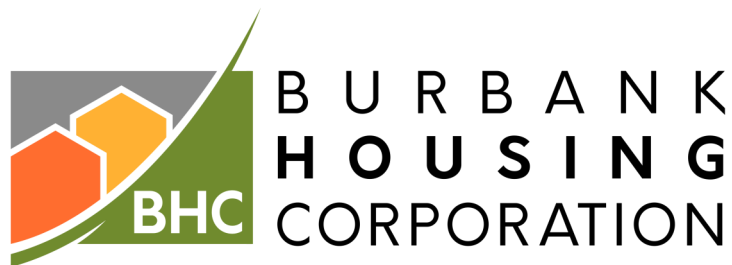


## Affordable Housing Program Apply for the Moderate Income Waiting List

Chartered in 1997 with the assistance of the City of Burbank's Redevelopment Agency, Burbank Housing Corporation (BHC) is a private, non-profit developer that operates an Affordable Housing Program in its 300+ rental units.

Applications are now available for the Moderate Income Waiting List for our Affordable Housing Program. Eligibility for the BHC Waiting List is based on household's size & gross annual income. In order to apply for the Moderate Income Waiting List, your household's gross annual income must fall into the income guidelines per the following chart:
