KEY TERMS

ABUSIVE LANGUAGE: Abusive language means harsh, violent, profane, or derogatory language which would demean the dignity of an individual and which shall include profanity and racial, ethnic, sexist slurs, or slurs based on color, religion, or national origin.

INCITE OTHER TO ACT IN A NEGATIVE WAY: Using terms in instigate negative actions. Examples may include, "meet me in the parking lot", "let's take this outside," "come at me," ect.

FOUL OR OBSCENE LANGUAGE: Expressions such as swear words that are regarded as coarse, obscene, or otherwise unacceptable in polite or formal speech.

NON-INJURY PHYSICAL ALTERCATION: Examples may include: chest or shoulder bump, impeeding on someones personal space

INJURY RELATED PHYSICAL ALTERCATION: Push, strike, swing, spit, trip

ROUGH TATICS: Examples may include: hard fouls, hitting up the middle, slide tackles, phycial contact during otherwise non physical contact plays (running the bases). FORCIBLE ACTION: The use of physical power or violence. For example, throwing objects or equipment,
