

WASTE REDUCTION REGULATIONS ORDINANCE FOR BUSINESSES

AT THE REGISTER



- ASK BEFORE GIVING customers any utensils, straws, napkins or other single-use accessories at the drive-thru.
- Only give utensils, straws, and napkins, etc. in to-go orders WHEN REQUESTED.
- **DO NOT** automatically include these items in the order.
- DINE-IN ORDERS must be served on REUSABLES.
- CONSUMER-OWNED CONTAINERS may be accepted for drink and food orders.
- DOGGY BAGS or single-use containers for leftovers must be compostable or recyclable.



- **SEPARATE WASTE** into the Three-Bin System:
- Organics/Food Waste must go in the ORGANICS GREEN BIN.
- Recyclables must go in the BLUE RECYCLING BIN.
- Not recyclable or compostable? Put in BLACK GARBAGE BIN.

WHAT IS RECYCLABLE IN BURBANK? Metal containers and aluminum foil, glass containers, corrugated cardboard, paper, and plastics #1, #2, and non-black #5

AB619 **REUSABLE CONTAINERS** Multiuse utensils

California Retail Food Code, Sections 114121 and 114353

Clean consumer-owned containers provided or returned to the food facility for filling. It may be filled by either an employee of the food facility or the owner of the container, and returned to the same consumer.





The food facility shall either isolate the consumer-owned containers from the serving surface or sanitize the serving surface after each filling.

The food facility shall prepare, maintain, and adhere to written procedures to prevent cross contamination ·and to make the written procedures available to the enforcement agency.





Clean consumer-owned containers shall be designed and constructed to be durable to retain their quality under normal use.

Consumer-owned containers that are not food specific maybe filled at a water vending machine or system.
